

## CUTBIRTH

Benjamin Cutbirth b.1740 Augusta Co., Va. d.1817 Maury Co., Tenn. of Scotch-Irish ancestry. When he was young his father died and his mother md. again. He migrated when he became grown to Rowan Co., N.C. on the Yadkin River. And became a friend of Daniel Boone, md. Elizabeth Wilcoxson a niece of Daniel Boone. He became one of the "Long Hunters". They made a trip to New Orleans. When they returned home he moved to Madison Co., Ky. but lost his land there and moved back to N.C. Then he moved to the Blue Ridge in Ashe Co., ca. 2 miles north of Deep Gap. Then moved to the south fork of the New River ca. 2 or 3 miles above the Old Fields until after the Revolutionary War. About 1797 he was listed in Carter Co., Tenn. owning one slave. In 1811 he and his son Daniel were on the tax list in Maury Co., Tenn. He was described as- stout, well built ca. 5 feet 10 inches tall, dark complexion and hair. had very little to say except when with an old friend then they would talk all night about religion or hunting. He had very little education. It is thought he and his wife were bur. in the Howell Cemetery in Giles Co., very near the Maury Co., line, with no markers???? They had 4 children; Benjamin, Mary, Sarah, Daniel Cutbirth.

4. Daniel Cutbirth b.1760/61 prob. Rowan Co., N.C. He was sent back to Pennsylvania to school and prob. was well educated at that time. He md. 1780/84 to Elizabeth Coleman b.20 Feb. 1763 d.19 Apr. 1848 (her mother was a Williams). It is thought they moved to Maury Co., Tenn. bef. 1811 with his parents Benjamin and Elizabeth Wilcoxson Cutbirth. He owned land in 14th Dist. Giles Co., Tenn. on Big Creek. He d. bef. 1838 and prob. bur. in Gibsonville Cem. north of Campbellsville with no marker. Elizabeth sold her interest in the home place to Alexander Scott in 1846 and was to make her home there. But she passed away 19 Apr. 1848, believed to be at the home of her dau.

Sarah Anderson in Hickman Co., Tenn and was bur. in old well cem. near where her dau. lived. They had 11 children; Benjamin, Elizabeth, Daniel Boone, Rachel, Sarah, Mary, Sabra, Sampson, George, Delilah, Delany Cutbirth.
