Excerpts from "The Old Dutch Meeting House"  
by Mary Weitman

"The history of the New Jerusalem Church which was established in 1815, is closely connected with that of the Heidelberg Luthern Church, "Dutch Meeting Housu", as it was founded by members of the old church, who desired a place of worship nearer their homes. Although the Lutherans were largely responsible for the erection of this church, and other denominations were allowed to preach here.

The land on which the church stood was a gift to the congregation from Nicholas Click, Sr., who had been a leading member of the old "Dutch Meeting House".

The original petition was drawn August 15, 1815 in Rowan County, N.C. Nicholas Click, Sr. obligated himself to give to the managers of said establishment two acres of land, and free privilege to the spring as long as the said church is kept up with decency to God and man.

Nicholas Click, Sr. was one of the managers of said petition. Nicholas Click, Jr. was one of the three trustees elected at the first meeting. Daniel Click was later appointed as a trustee to fill the vacancy due to the death of Henry Clement, Sr.

The days of the New Jerusalem Meeting House were drawing to a close, as many of its members had united with other denominations through out the county, and in the year 1868 the substantial old log building began its career as a school house.

A list of teachers in the old Jerusalem school from 1879-1900 included S. J. Tatum."

The Jerusalem Baptist Church was organized in 1868.

# History of the Click Family in Davie County

by  
Professor J. D. Hodges  
copied by Flossie Martin.

For more than two hundred years, it has been the law in the great Roman Empire that all able bodied young men shall serve in the Roman Army for seven years.

About the year 1750, a young man of the middle-class, while thus serving, in the army as an officer, was, as he imagined, insulted by a superior officer. The young soldier promptly challenged his superior to a settlement of the matter on "the field of honor". Equally prompt was the superior in accepting the challenge.

Stripped to the waist, and armed with short swords, the Combatants met on the field and in the very act of engaging in the bloody fray, when they were surprised by the German authorities. This prevented the fight; and, since it was death by the laws for men to engage in killing, in Germany, at this time, these young men scampered off the field, to escape arrest, they concealed themselves in the forest.

Without waiting to speak a farewell to friends or to receive the blessings of his mother or the parting kiss of one he loved more than any mother, the subject of this sketch fled the country, seeking a refuge and a home in the new world. He succeeded in avoiding capture, and finally reached a German colony in Maryland. By gentle conduct, sober and industrious habits, he became a popular young man in his adopted home, in the new world.

Forgetting his early love in the "Father land", he sought and won the heart of Elizabeth Harmon (See later note, F.M.) a Maryland Lassie, a year his junior.

These young people early joined that continuous and notable stream of emigration from Maryland and Pennsylvania to North Carolina, which began about 1745, and continued until after the American Revolution. They bought land in this immediate community, the site this building occupies being a part of the purchase.

The man's name was Nicholas Gluck, the German for Luck. It is not known with absolute certainty when Mr. Gluck came to this country, but from the best information I can get, it must have been about the year 1755. He built the house in which our neighbor, Mr. W. A. Kingston, now lives, but had previously lived in a house nearby. Exactly when it was built we do not know, but we do know it was doing service during the Revolutionary War.

Mr. Gluck raised five boys and three girls whose names are as follows:

1. Nicholas who was 12 years old at the close of the Revolution
2. Jacob
3. John Whom see
4. Daniel
5. Michael
6. Elizabeth
7. Sarah
8. Rebecca

The eldest daughter was never married, died at age of 92 and was buried in the Click graveyard a mile from here, as was her father, who lived to be 84 years old, and her sister Susan who also, was never married. The second daughter, Elizabeth married a man in Rowan County now Salisbury. She had several children.

Mr. Click's (Gluck) second son was John. He was never married and died in early manhood.

Mr. Gluck's third son was Jacob who married and settled the lands now known as the Anderson Daniel and Henry Beck lands. About the year 1830 he removed to Washington County in the state of Indiana. He lived to a great old age and raised a large family.

Mr. Gluck's fourth son was named Daniel. He was born October 31, 1800; Died December 7, 1845. He married Mary Ann Ratts, of Davidson County, to this union was born son and daughters as follows:  
 Henry Harman Click who built the house in which Mac. Deadman now lives. He died in 1851, leaving a large family. He was twice married. First to Miss Owens, last to Elizabeth Snider. (Sarah Owens, sister of Leah Owens) PT  
 The second son was John who first settled on the Ham Everhart land, then in "The horse-shoe neck" where he died, leaving a large family.  
 The third son was John Nicholas, who lived and died on the Yadkin River on the lands now owned by Mrs. Mail his last wife and Mrs. John Cope his only daughter.  
 The fourth son was Godfrey who married a Miss Graham in Rowan county and settled on what is now Albert Miller's land. He removed to Olin, in Iredell County and died there leaving two sons and three daughters. (See A. G. Click) PT  
 The fifth son was Michael who died in 1849, at the age of 27 unmarried.  
 The sixth son was Jesse Daniel, who married Mary Crump and then Jane Waddell, dying at Elmwood, where he had lived many years, leaving only one living child, Annie.  
 The first daughter was Rebecca who died in 1845 and was never married.  
 The second daughter was Mary Magdalena who married J. W. Hodges and died at Augusta in 1901 aged 83 years and three months, leaving an only son and two living daughters.  
 The third daughter was Mary Elizabeth who died in 1820.  
 The fourth daughter was Sophia Catherine who married Ezra Washington Tatum. She died some years since leaving several children well known to the people of this community, at this time.

The fifth and youngest son of Mr. Gluck, the original settler, was Michael. He married a Miss Butler. He lived and died just east of the Docter Wiseman orchard in this village. His sons were Elisha, Nicholas, now living with Billy Click and is 84 years old and Michael, who still lives. The daughters were: Mary who married Jacob Crim, a Southern minister. After living some years on the Bost lands, at South River, this family removed to Tanglewood Texas and raised a large family. Rebecca was another daughter, who married C. W. Bessent, a Baptist minister who lived in this village and is well remembered. Another daughter was Clementia who married Wilburn Foster and died two miles from here on the lands now owned by John Garrwood. The other daughters were, Sallie, Edith and Angetta, none of whom were ever married.

This completes the genealogy of the boys raised by this original German settler, Mr. Cluck. His daughters were Elizabeth, Sarah and Rebecca. Elizabeth married a Graves, lived and died on the land now owned by Goshen McCulloch. There were a number of children. Sarah married a Butler and died without issue. Rebecca married Tenison Cheshire and lived a little north of Mocksville, raising a number of children.

This completes the record of the descendants of Nicholaus Gluck original ancestor of the numerous Click family in this community.

In this family, as well as in all other German families, the German language was used exclusively in the home and in the schools until about the year 1825. Even at this late date, only the children used the English language continuously. The older people used the English language only when visited by English speaking people.

About this time, 1825, these good German people began to associate with people of other nationalities. An interest in county, state and national policies sprang up. They began to angalise their names. Huhn was written for Huhn, Barringer for Behringer, Blackwelder for Schwartzwalder. So our Mr. Gluck changed his name from Gluck to click. The name has been further changed and is now spelled Click.

In conclusion I may remark that this has been a large and somewhat remarkable family. They have been an industrious and a law abiding people, not given to strife or litigations. They have been an honest, frugal and church going people. In every contest in which our country has been engaged this family has furnished its ample quota. It had representatives in the war of 1812, in the Mexican War and in the great struggle between the North and South. In its long history, not one has ever been convicted of crime, not one has ever been in jail. Only one has ever been under arrest and that was afterwards shown to have been false. Its present representatives may well cherish a just pride in its antecedents and feel an aspiration towards righteous conduct and good citizenship.
